

Dear Emergency Shelter Staff,

The Domestic Violence Transitional Shelter Coalition has been working to streamline the TS application process to support domestic violence survivors in their effort to become independent. We developed a joint application form that you can use to apply to all of the TS programs listed in the chart. This way, you can just fill out the form once and fax to as many as you feel there is a fit. We ask that you check for space and program fit, given the goals of your client, before sending the application.

Some TS programs have additional questions that you will need to include when faxing the application to them. As the process can be confusing, please refer to the chart and fax the completed forms yourself. Please DO NOT have your clients contact us directly.

2. Recommendation Letter that you need to fill out
3. Addendums you submit according to the TS programs you are applying to
